

Register for universal infant free school meals now!

Since September 2014, all children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 have been offered a free school meal at no cost to the parent or guardian*. School meals in Enfield are healthy, tasty, social and fun and choosing a school lunch for your child/children will help save you up to £400 per year if you decide to take up the offer.

In Enfield this has proved popular with parents and children alike. If you have a child who will be in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 in September 2015, please complete the short form overleaf and return to your child's school as soon as possible.

Quality food, every day...

The majority of meals in Enfield primary schools are provided by Enfield Catering Services. The Service has been awarded the prestigious Soil Association's Silver Catering Mark and has committed to the following:

- Using seasonal and locally sourced produce – for example many of the salad items are from the Lea Valley area.
- Using locally sourced free-range eggs.
- Providing a daily unlimited salad bar.
- Food is freshly cooked on site from unprocessed ingredients.
- A strong commitment to animal welfare, all the meat purchased is classed under a farm-assurance scheme.
- Using fish that is Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) certified, i.e. from sustainable stocks and not contributing to the problem of over fishing.
- Using some organic foods e.g. milk, oats and yoghurts.
- Healthy and nutritious menus which meet the Government nutrition standards.
- No undesirable additives or trans fats.

Yes they can, but we would encourage them to try a school lunch. This will give them a varied and balanced diet and save you time and money. Even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal, we would encourage you to complete the form so that your child's school receives as much funding as possible. It is really important that you complete all of the information asked for in this form as this will help us to see if your child's school is entitled to claim additional grant money called the 'Pupil Premium'.

To help us plan for the numbers of children having a school lunch from September 2015 and ensure that your child's school receives as much funding as possible, please provide the details requested on the form overleaf and return to your child's school as soon as possible.

*NB. A cash alternative is not available for those pupils not taking a school lunch from September 2015.
